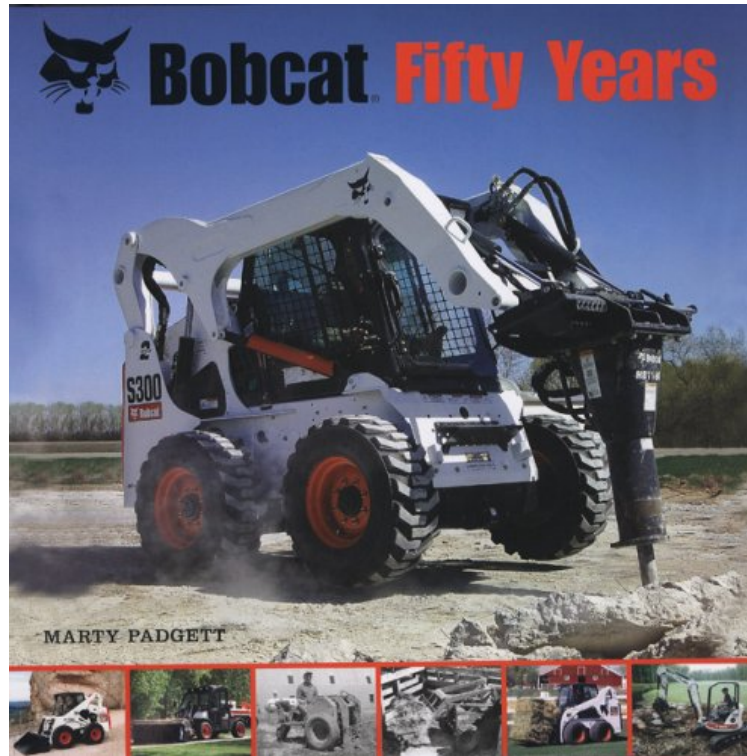

It's more for the Skid Loader or Bobcat enthusiast, definitely not a kids book. The form, look and feel of the book is similar to some of the nicer Corvette or Mustang books you often see at book stores, where it's got a lot of nice, color pictures, reprints of advertisements, pictures of people using the skid loader back in the day ...and so on. This book was commissioned by Bobcat, so it has all of the backing and resources (pictures, interviews, historical archives) of the factory. There is a nice section on the history and men involved in the early days, interviews of surviving early members and the things they rememberand problems they encountered which led to various product enhancements during the early days. It covers bobcat skid loaders up to the S and T series to 2007 (when my book was published). I would like to have seen a little more information about the competition during the early days (other popular skid loaders) and how their features may have driven product enhancements.
