

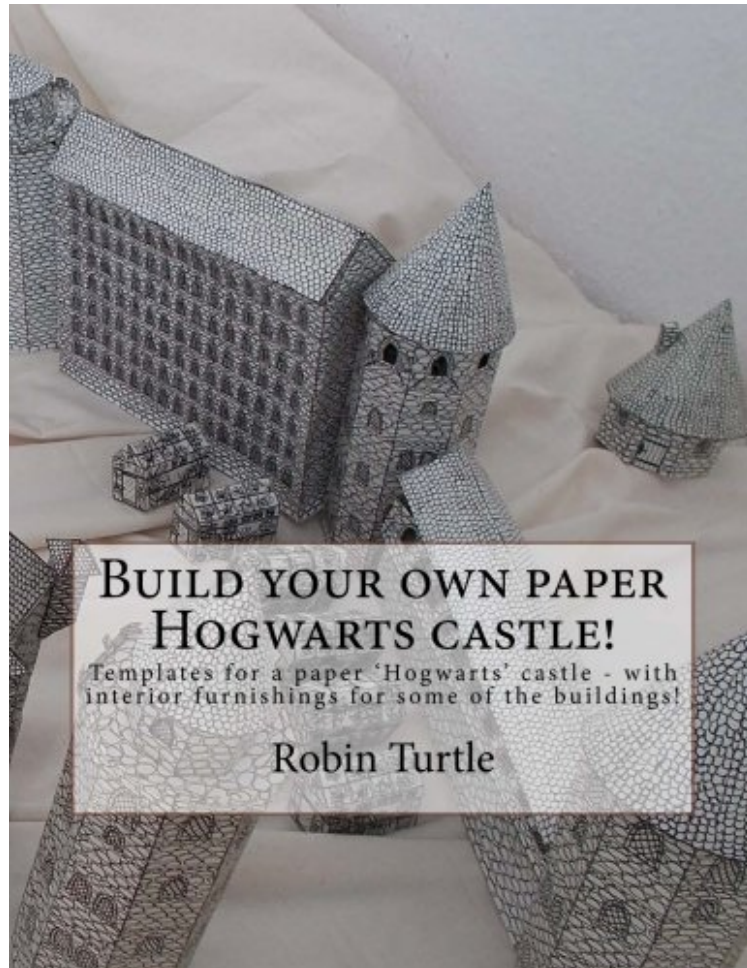

The special thing about this castle is that some of the buildings are designed to be opened (like the Entrance building and the staircase tower) and have a removable roof and they also have a complete interior, even with miniature pieces of furniture (the Gryffindor Common Room and dormitory, the Owlery and the Great Hall)!! This is sooo cute. Hagrid's cabin is also a highlight - small, cute and round, and its roof can be removed and it has all the furniture. Just lovely! It is my favourite of the buildings and has a place of honour in

my bookshelf. The templates are in black-and-white and we coloured them in as we prefer coloured buildings, but they can also be left as is. The castle was obviously hand-drawn by the illustrator and this gives it a very personal and special character, not like the cold, unpersonal 'official' Hogwarts depictions out there that were created on a computer.

We very much prefer this castle!! Anyway, the castle is a lovely addition to every Harry Potter fan collection.

This book contains templates for 20 self-contained paper buildings for a Hogwarts castle complex some of them even have a fully furnished interior and removable roof, like the Gryffindor Common Room and Dormitory, the Great Hall, the Owlery, Hagrids cabin and the Staircase and Entrance Hall! Some of the buildings have been designed with identical measurements so that even parts of them can be mixed and matched for more variety. All buildings can stand alone or be put up as part of the castle complex. The templates were hand-drawn with a quill and ink from a bottle in a process taking several weeks, which gives them a unique quaint and personal touch which cannot be achieved with computer-assisted design. The buildings are in black-and-white and can be coloured in according to individual preferences.
