In 2002 ARNOLDSCHÉ published the compendious work by the collector and writer Jochen Amme, *Historic Cutlery - Changing Shapes from the Palaeolithic to the 20th Century* (664 pages, 440 colour plates, ISBN 9783897901674). The book presented here is a supplement to that ground-breaking work.
