While other reviewers found the author's writing style "clear," I did not. References go nowhere, instructions are either over- or under-written, etc.; the book is a plethora of mistakes. My biggest complaint is that while technique sequences have numbers, the numbers aren't included in the written instructions. Why have numbers if they aren't going to provide a link to what you're suppose to do! (Then there was the reference to "Chapter 10" when there isn't a Chapter 10 in the book.) I can forgive a few editing errors, but this book has too many of them.
