

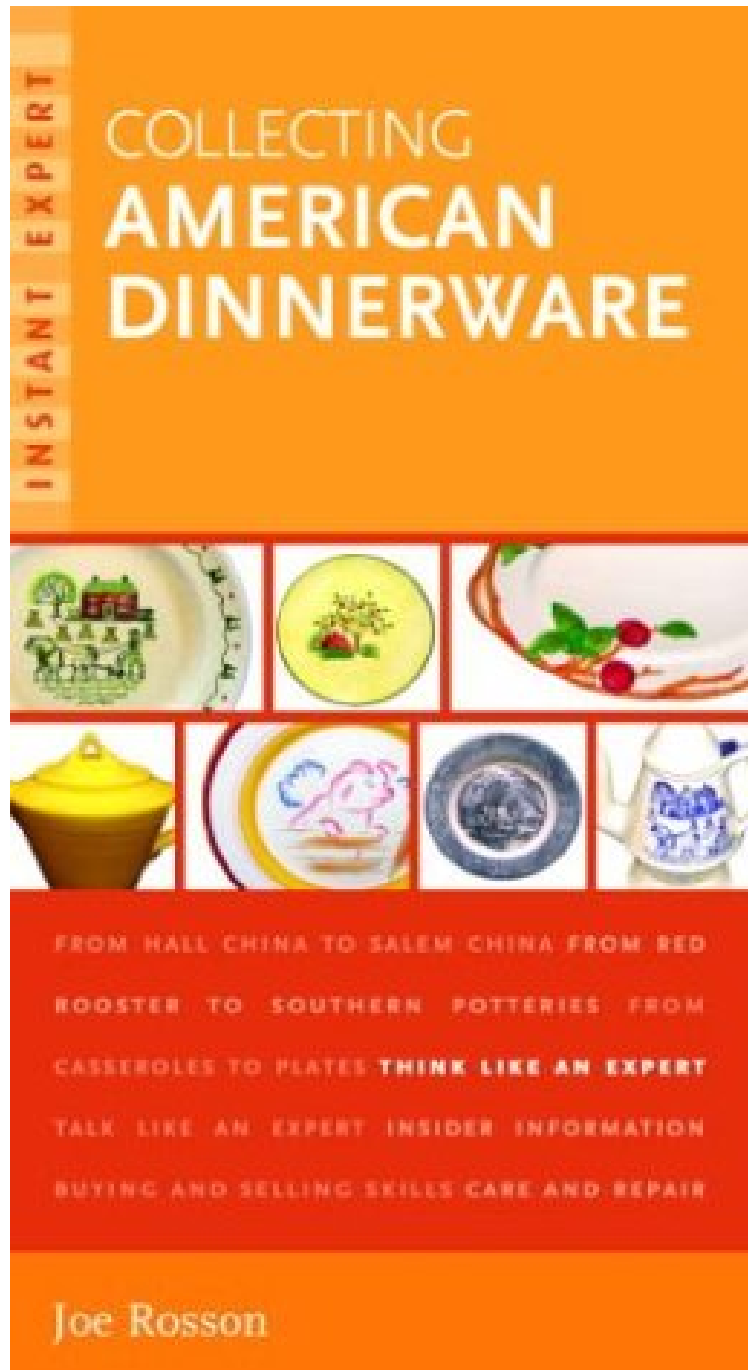

This book has a lot of good, basic information about collecting American Dinnerware. It's probably best suited to those who are a novice to the field or just want a quick reference book on some of the most common dinnerware companies. There is some interesting information on the old pottery and china companies that once dotted the landscape of the US, but are now long gone. There is also some tips on identifying good pieces and avoiding bad ones for collectors. If you like lots of photographs this book will disappoint. There are a few here and there, but all are black and white. The illustrations of maker's marks are helpful, but far from exhaustive. Overall I found the book to be useful and worth buying, but limited in information.
