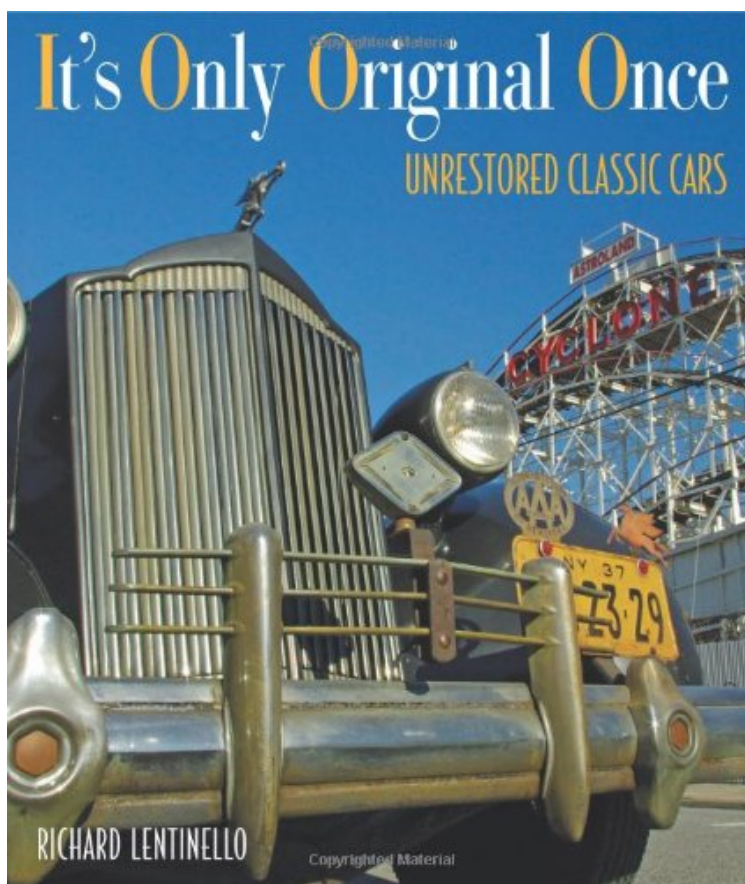

And these are the cars pictured and profiled in this book in all their original glory. Survivor cars are the highlights of collector-car auctions around the world, the stars of their
