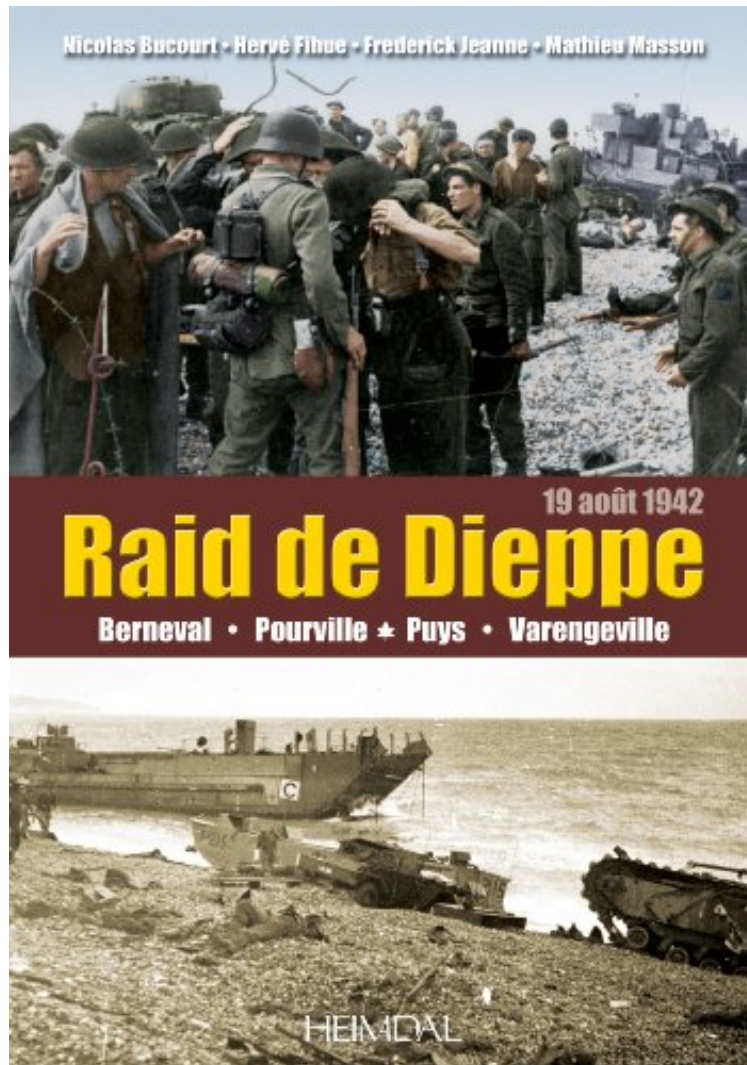

This book has so much more, from planning to the aftermath of the raid. Pictures are many, mostly that I haven't seen before, reproduced well. The maps are useful. The only complaint is that it's entirely in French. Unfortunately Heimdal stopped their bi-lingual books sometime around 2011, so unless you read French the text captions are rather useless. A shame as these books were still seem to be top

references. It may have gotten 5 stars from this review if it was readable.

The first attempt at landing in Normandy ended in a bloody failure. The authors go back over this operation with 80 unpublished German photos taken after the raid, adding to the important iconographic documentation with pictures and photos of equipment found there.
