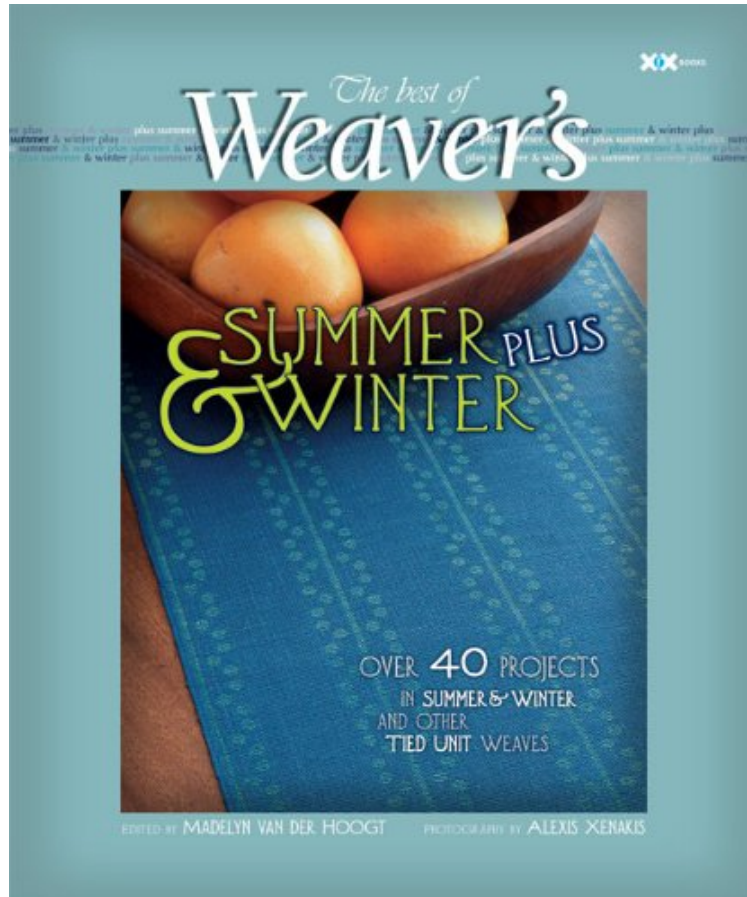


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Summer and Winter Plus: The Best of Weaver's (Best of Weaver's series)
