The Queen Anne movement can be extremely perplexing as it was exceedingly complex in both its sources and its manifestations, both in the United States and in Great Britain. For decades it was either ignored or dismissed as utter rubbish. This book snatches the movement from the dustbin of architectural history and sheds much light (as well as sweetness) on it. Its primary focus is on its development in England with cursory comments regarding its development in the United States. The differences between the two are immense to the point that later developments almost make them seem to be two unrelated styles.
