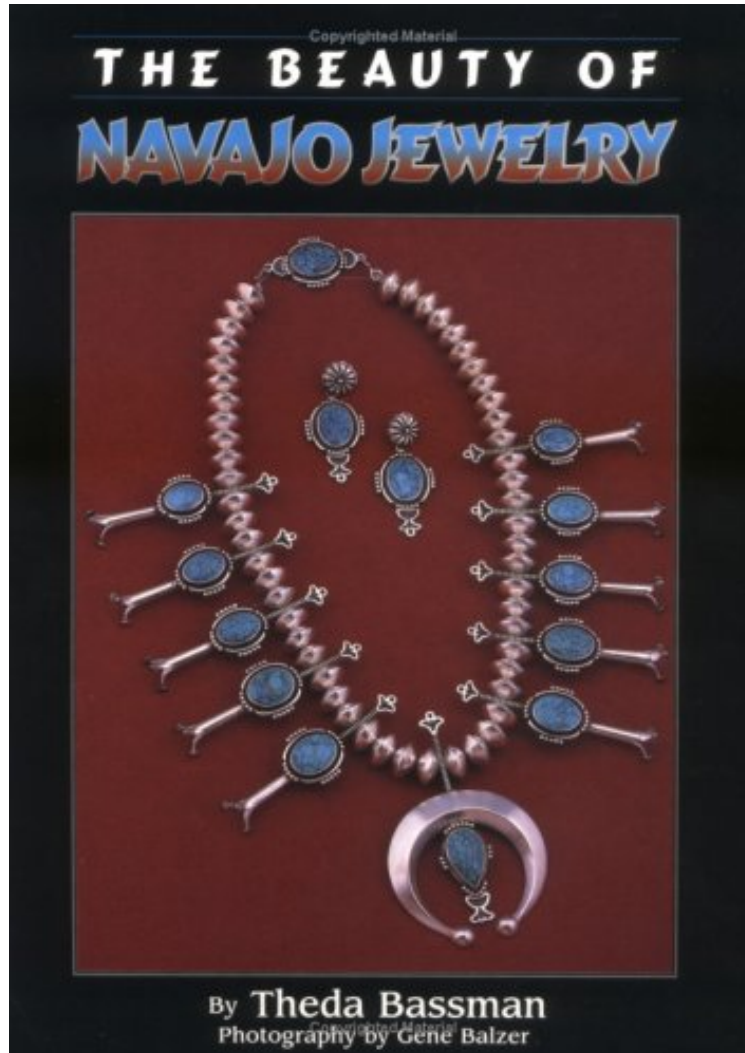

Now that I am older and am able to begin acquiring some for myself, I have spent some time trying to get educated on the art and artists. There is quite a bit of information free on-line about the topic and I am also learning through corresponding with various folks in the business. When I saw this book was available, it seemed like a natural resource to continue that education.Content of this book:- the first three pages are an introduction and give a brief history of the tribe, how they came to become so skilled in silverwork, and the role of pawning within the culture- the

remainder of the book is dedicated to photographs of various pieces of jewelry including pieces that are older, more current pieces, and those made from silver, gold, and set with stones. If you are looking for an idea of what "good" Native American jewelry is, this is a great book as it shows high quality pieces from famous/well-known artists. There is a lot of junk out there and even chain clothing stores are selling turquoise jewelry. That is fine if you realize what you are purchasing, but when you see the photographs of these works of art, the difference is obvious. The jewelry photographed has been supplied from various sources such as the artists themselves, private collections, and some well-respected retail establishments. If you are looking for an in-depth resource on how jewelry is made or more historical perspective, this isn't for you.
