The Complete Book of Tapestry Weaving does not examine individual tapestries, it notes the changing relationship through the centuries between tapestry weaver and painter. This book explores how tapestry weaving is closely related to drawing and painting. Drawing and tapestry weaving are concurrent activities, and if you are hesittnt about drawing as many weavers are, the sooner you become engaged in the excitement of making your own drawings, the better. The aim in presenting this book of tapestry weaving is not to cover everything, but to make a well-balanced start, in which the tapestry weaver is also the artist and, as a result, the innovator rather than the imitator. This book is very well

illustrated and gives interesting information about historical and modern tapestry and their making.
