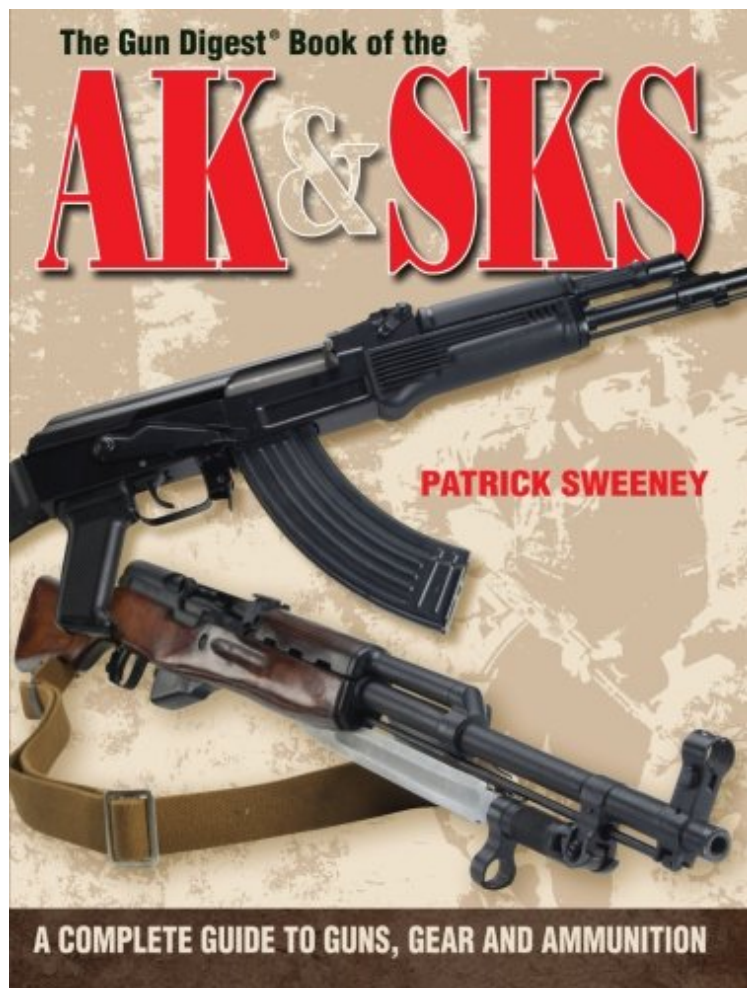

Many, many typos that make you wonder why a simple spell checker wasn't used. Also, the author's writing style turned me off at first but as I came to the realization that he knows his stuff I liked it better. It's almost like sitting down with an expert and shooting the bull - not polished, not perfectly organized but you sure learn a lot. A glossary would have helped with his terminology, google will help of course. All that aside, this is a perfect first book on the AK that is up to date plus it gives you a little on its kissin' cousin the SKS. Highly recommended!
